

9-0 Lancers bop Solon; Mt. Vernon is playoff foe

Tom Kopatich might be the least excited 9-0 coach in the history of high school football.

Not that the LaSalle football coach isn't happy that his Lancers finished the regular season unbeaten with a 34-6 thrashing of Solon Friday night at Kingstons Stadium.

It's just that Kopatich is looking ahead to the upcoming Class 2A state playoffs with such resolve. The Lancers, the defending state champ and the No. 1-ranked team all season, host Mount Vernon in the first round Wednesday at Kingstons at 7:30 p.m.

"I guess in a month or so it will all mean more," said Kopatich, whose team is the first LaSalle club ever to go unbeaten in the regular season. "But right now we have other things to think about."

Like going 12-0.

The Lancers didn't appear to be thinking too far ahead Friday as they netted 328 yards on the ground and pretty much took care of things with a 21-point second quarter.

Solon, led by quarterback Steve Donohue and end Troy Greene, made a gutsy comeback and eventually spoiled the shutout in the second half. But the Lancers were in control most of the way.

They fumbled the ball away the first time they had it but then scored on four straight possessions to take a 27-0 halftime lead.

The first scoring march covered 64 yards with a 26-yard pass from Darrell Schulte to Bruce Miller

setting up a one-yard scoring lunge by running back Chris Stark.

The second drive belonged to the other of the Lancers' rotating running backs, Derek Lewis, who accounted for 51 yards on a 58-yard march. He slashed 30 yards up the middle for the TD that made it 12-0.

Stark then raced 64 yards up the sideline on an option play to set up a one-yard sneak by Schulte, and the quarterback's conversion pass to Tom Mottet made it 20-0.

With time running out in the half, Schulte fired a 41-yard completion to Randy Dvorak, then tossed a 21-yard scoring pass to Miller to make it 27-0 at intermission.

Third-string running back Randy Banes notched the final TD with a five-yard run in the third quarter.

Stark led a balanced attack with 136 yards on just 11 carries.

Solon marched 64 yards for its only points early in the final period as Donohue threw to Greene down the middle. He broke a tackle at the six-yard line and carried two Lancers into the end zone to complete the 20-yard play.

Greene, a 6-foot-6 junior, snared 10 passes for 109 yards while teammate Dan Fiala caught five for 32. Both players finished with 39 receptions for the season, breaking the school record of 36. Fiala's career total of 63 is also a record.

Donohue also enjoyed a good night, rebounding from a sub-par first half to complete 18 of 33 tries for 148 yards.

Among the spectators was World Series hero Mike Boddicker, whose wife, Lisa, attended LaSalle.

Jeff rips West for only win, 42-7

IOWA CITY — Cedar Rapids Jefferson won its first and last football game of the season Friday night, rolling to an easy 42-7 victory over outmanned Iowa City West.

The J-Hawks controlled the line on both offense and defense against the smaller Trojan line.

Offensively, Jefferson was able to move the ball at will stacking up more than 400 yards total offense.

Defensively, Jefferson snuffed drive after drive, allowing West only five first downs. Two of those came as a result of penalties.

"This is the way it has been all year," said J-Hawk Coach Bill Calloway. "We're a good football team, but it has been a strange year."

Senior flanker Bob Driscoll (6-4, 204) caught five passes for 148 yards and two touchdowns.

"He's a big time prospect," said

Calloway. "He has excellent hands and good speed."

Another senior, quarterback Marty Pearson, also had a good finale completing 7 of 16 passes for 190 yards and four touchdowns.

West's only score came in the third quarter when senior fullback Ben Eskin broke open off right tackle and galloped 57 yards for the touchdown.

Jefferson held the Trojans to less than 150 yards, forcing seven turnovers, including six interceptions.

Eskin led the West offensive effort with 87 yards on 13 carries.

Jefferson sophomore halfback Randy Meier scored three touchdowns, one coming on an 8-yard pass from Pearson and the other two on runs of 3 and 22 yards.

Jefferson took the lead on the first possession when Pearson hit Driscoll on a 51-yard bomb.

On the ensuing kickoff, the J-Hawks surprised West with an onside kick

which kicker Mark Tiedtke recovered himself at the West 48.

One play later, Pearson found Driscoll open on the same play, this time for 43 yards, giving Jefferson a 13-0 lead after less than four minutes.

The J-Hawks piled up 250 yards total offense in the first half, most coming from the Pearson-Driscoll connection.

West's bright spot in the first half came when defensive back Carl Jackson made a spectacular touchdown-saving interception on a long pass from Pearson.

The rest of the first half was pretty dismal for West. The Trojans were able to gain only 38 yards.

The J-Hawks' other score came when junior split end Jim Lockett made a diving catch of a Pearson pass in the end zone late in the third quarter.

Jefferson finished the year 1-7, 1-6 in the Mississippi Valley Conference. West finished 0-9 and 0-7.

Wash upsets No. 2 Hempstead

DUBUQUE — The Cedar Rapids Washington football team may want to schedule all of its games in Dubuque next season.

Greg Hilder pulled in 11 Bob Hoppel passes for 128 yards and a touchdown, and Tony Collins scored on a school-record 95-yard run as the Warriors topped previously unbeaten and second-ranked Dubuque Hempstead, 21-14, in a Mississippi Valley Conference football finale Friday night.

Playoff bound and Valley champion Hempstead, which finished the regular season 8-1 overall, 6-1 in conference, became Washington's second Dubuque victim this fall. Washington, 6-3, 5-2, beat highly-touted and playoff bound

Wahlert, 13-10, earlier in the year at Dubuque.

Collins, a 187-pound senior tailback, took a Hoppel handoff from his own five-yard-line on the first play of the second period and raced all the way to the end zone for the game's first score. Collins' run broke Bill Keister's previous Washington best from scrimmage (84 yards against Kennedy in 1976).

Hoppel, who completed 12 consecutive passes at one point and finished 19-of-24 for 220 yards, later connected with Steve Bjornsen on a nine-yard touchdown pass before the half.

Hilder, a 175-pound senior split end, later scored on a 10-yard pass from

Happel midway through the third quarter for what proved to be the game-winner.

Collins, who rushed for 111 yards on 10 carries, also caught six passes for 76 yards. Kicker Jeff Wulf accounted for all three Warrior PATs.

Hempstead quarterback Jim Arneson had his problems against a typically tough Hoppel pass defense. Arneson, who scored on a 10-yard run just before intermission, completed just 5-of-23 passes for 76 yards. He was intercepted once.

Matt MacNider, who rushed for 75 yards on 18 carries, scored the other Mustang TD on a one-yard plunge.

Kennedy loses, 14-12

CEDAR FALLS — Cedar Rapids Kennedy was held scoreless for 44 minutes by Cedar Falls, and had a rally fall short, 14-12, Friday night in the high school football finale for both teams at the UNI-Dome.

Cedar Falls struck first in the second quarter at the 11:05 mark. Chris Lilly, who has broken nearly all the Cedar Falls receiving records, caught a 23-yard pass from Rick Majerus. Scott Peterson kicked the extra point.

Cedar Falls scored with 6:54 gone in the third quarter when Majerus hit Doyle Hansen coming out of the backfield for a 13-yard pass. Again, Peterson added the extra point.

In the second half Kennedy replaced starting quarterback Larry Thomas with Andy Beer.

With 3:31 left in the game, and Kennedy behind 14-0, the Cougars

scored when Jeff Pavek ramblled in from the 3-yard line. Kennedy was penalized on the first extra point attempt and the second try for the conversion kick was wide.

Cedar Falls controlled the ball for the next two minutes until their second-string quarterback fumbled and Kennedy recovered on the Cedar Falls' 32-yard line.

Two plays later, Beer hooked up with Kris Kvach for a 25-yard touchdown pass that put Kennedy within two points, 14-12.

The Cougars' try for two points, however, was stopped when the Tigers' Denny Hansen blindsided Kvach, who was trying to pass.

Beer finished the game with 8 completions on 10 attempts for 98 yards. Kennedy finished the season 5-4.
