IOWA CITY — Durant-Bennett tried to make things interesting for undefeated Iowa City Regina, recovering an onside kick to start the game and forcing a fumble on the Class 2A top-ranked team's first possession.

That didn't last long. The Regals returned an interception for a touchdown on Durant's following drive and found the end zone on five of their next six drives in a 42-0 win last night at Regina Stadium.

For Regina, the surprise onside kick and early turnover provided the toughest test — as brief as it was - the Regals have seen since a 21-15 win over Solon five weeks ago.

"Sudden change is something you have to be ready for," Regina Coach Marv Cook said. "Our defense really came through. Any time you're stressed, it's good. You have to control the ups and the downs.

The Regals (7-0, 5-0) have outscored district opponents 242-12 in five games, usually with most of their starters sitting out the second half.

Limited snaps for the starters hasn't caused the team to become less sharp or lose focus, quarterback Jack Verducci said. The Regals, who finish with Louisa-Muscatine and West Liberty, use practice to replicate high-stress game situations, emphasizing mechanics and fundamentals.

We're looking to take care of these two weeks before the playoffs," Verducci said.
